

**Duke University String School
Scholarship Assistance
2020 – 2021 Application**

COVID disclaimer: Ensemble scholarships will apply to the small ensembles, theory, and chamber music groups we are able to safely conduct during the fall of 2020. Any cancellation of ensembles will result in the option to request a prorated rebate for future participation or prorated refund of payment.

Under the Duke University String School (DUSS) **Dorothy Kitchen Scholarship Fund**, families may apply for scholarship assistance. Scholarships cover 75%, 50%, or 25% of tuition costs and may be applied to Ensemble/Group Classes, Chamber Music, and/or Private Lessons.

Scholarship awards are based on availability of funds in the scholarship program and approval by the DUSS Director based one or more of the following criteria:

1. **Financial need:** a copy of the most recent year's 1040 tax return is required.
2. **Parent involvement:** such as ensemble assistant, accompanist, concert coordinator, etc.
3. **Stephanie Swisher Ensemble Scholarship:** for participation on a second instrument (viola, cello, bass) in an additional ensemble. Scholarship covers 100% of second ensemble fee.

Scholarship Assistance is open to all registered students who provide a complete and accurate application with supporting documentation, meet the criteria, and have no outstanding fees.

Students applying for assistance for the first time are required to ask for a recommendation from a teacher or other adult supervisor (i.e. classroom teacher, choir conductor, after school program director, etc). Your referral should include information on the student's character, ability on their instrument if applicable, and family commitment and must be sent directly to the DUSS director via email at erica.shirts@duke.edu.

Applications and any supporting documents must be received by Friday, August 21, 2020.

Due to Covid19, we prefer that you email your documents. Please redact (blackout) any sensitive information, or add a password protection to the forms. Email to: erica.shirts@duke.edu.

Scholarship decisions are generally emailed within one week of the deadline. If a scholarship is awarded, the student will receive a Notice of Acceptance to sign. If a scholarship is not awarded, families will have an opportunity to submit a Notice of Appeal.

Any Notice of Acceptance must be signed by the applicant and returned to the Director within five (5) days, confirming:

1. Acceptance of the award and amount
2. Family member's agreement to help with the Parent Volunteer Committee
3. The applicant's commitment and obligation to pay the remaining balance due. (Note: When scholarships are awarded, the amount awarded will be applied to the fees, with the applicant responsible for paying the balance.)
4. Continuation of scholarship assistance each semester relies upon attendance, normal progress, and expected behavior.
